


MINOAN CIVILIZATION PEAKS

- 1900 BC
- First civilization in Greece.
- Sea empire based on trade.
- Invaded by Mycenaens




MYCENEAN CIVILIZATION BEGINS




- 1600 BC
- Civilization on the Greek mainland
- Warrior people
- Homer wrote about them.

MYCENEAN CIVILIZATION ENDS

- 1100 BC
- Massive earthquakes wipes out most of the civilization



GREEK DARK AGES



- 1100-750 BC
- Population declined/food production dropped
- Farming declines
- Trade and economic activity revival
- Iron weapons
- Adopted Phoenician alphabet

SPARTA: CONTROLLING ITS CITIZENS

- 800 600 BC
- Males spent childhood learning military discipline.
- Army ages 20 -30.
- Could vote
- Stayed in the army until age of 60.
- Women lived at home. Very independent



CITY-STATES DEVELOP



- 750 BC
- Distrusted one another
- Patriotic independent units (town, city, or village)
- Met in center for political, social, or religious activities.
- Broke into communities with common identities

GREEKS COLONIZE

- 750-550 BC
- Looking for good farmland and trade.
- Industry spread culture and political ideals
- Wealthy individuals developed



ATHENS UNIFIES

- 700 BC
- Aristocrats controlled the government
- Faced political turmoil because of serious economic problems
- Farmers were sold into slavery
- On the verge of civil war.
- Land was redistributed
- Assembly developed to vote on stuff.



PERSIAN WARS


- Persians first beaten by Athens in 490 BC.
- Persians invaded again for revenge (480 BC)
- Athens and Sparta fought together


ATHENS CREATES AN ALLIANCE

- 478 BC
- Delian League
 - Alliance against persions
 - Athenian leadership
 - Fought Persians to liberate Greeks
 - Everyone but Sparta joins



AGE OF PERICLES

- Athens became a direct democracy.
- Every male citizen belonged
- Most residents were NOT citizens.
- Poor people could participate in public affairs.
- Developed ostracism
 - Banning over ambitious politicians




ATHENS CREATES AN EMPIRE

- 445 BC
- Feared by other city-states
- Used money from the Delian League to build monuments and fund the military




PELOPONNESIAN WAR BEGINS



- 431 -405 BC
- Athenian empire vs Sparta
- Spartans surround Athens and Athenians won't come out
- Spartans throw dead bodies over the walls and kills 1/3 of the Athenian population with the plague
- In 405 the Athenian fleet is destroyed
- All city-states are weakened and now vulnerable to outside threats.

ATHENS LOSES TO SPARTA

- 405 BC
- Control shifts to Sparta but all citystates are weakened from the war.



ALEXANDER THE GREAT DIES



- 323 BC
- Macedonians (Barbarians) invade Greece and become a powerful kingdom in 338 BC
- Alexander takes over at the age of 20.
- Attacks Persia and loses.
- He dies at the age of 32 from exhaustion caused by wounds and to much alcohol
